Announcements

New: The Care Provider Management Bureau (CPMB) is working on the development and implementation of a new background check data system. The name of the system is Guardian and is expected to go live Fall 2020. Guardian will ensure background checks are completed faster and more efficiently, while making the process easier for applicants and facilities to request exemptions. Facilities will have the ability to process clearance and exemption transfers and will be able to manage their rosters online. Another added benefit of Guardian is the online payment capability for TrustLine and Home Care Aide Registry applicants and renewals. Users of Guardian will be able to upload documents electronically, check their exemption status and receive communications through their respective portals. New: California law has changed. The term "unsubstantiated" will be used for allegations that don't have enough evidence to prove that they happened. In the past, these were called "inconclusive." 
You will then be prompted that the data set may take up to 30 seconds to several minutes. Click confirm and the file will be downloaded into a .CSV file.
